

# Rules, Regulations, Syllabus for German 1 Class

- Ø All school rules are in effect at all times
- Ø Obey classroom rules as posted – including **NO GUM**
- Ø Always bring the *Admission Slip* if you were absent from class the day before
- Ø If you are absent from class for 30 minutes or more, you will be counted absent for class
- Ø Always report to class immediately; you will be marked *Tardy* otherwise
- Ø Computers/Internet will only be used for German class
- Ø Grading:
  - Daily participation will accumulate into bi-monthly participation grades (3 grades per 6 weeks)
  - Tests: 2x
  - Quizzes: 1x
  - 10 Homework assignments or in-class assignments will be picked up at random. 1x
  - Projects: 2x
  - Group/Partner work: 1x
  - Four Bell ringers plus one quiz count 1x (per week). **Bell ringers serve as review and re-teaching of vocabulary, grammar and cultural concepts. All bell ringers need to be studied!**
  - Grammatikheft (Workbooks) one grade per Unit completed
  - Quia Exercises online (in class and independently)
- Ø **YOU ALWAYS HAVE HOMEWORK! Even if no written work is assigned, you need to go over vocabulary, grammar concepts, reading, or notes from school. This is important!!!!**

## Materials Covered:

- Ø *German 1: Units 1 – 7* (1. Who Are You; 2. Fun and Games; 3. At Home; 4. Everything for School; 5. Buying Clothes; 6. Making Plans; 7. Helping Around the House); 8. Grocery Shopping (Einkaufen gehen) (one project; one reading assignment and research paper)
- Ø **Make-up work:**  
It is the student's task to ask a classmate what has been missed and then pick up the necessary worksheets or Bell ringers. Make-up work can be placed in the appropriate folder or be submitted to [deutsch@hampshirehigh.com](mailto:deutsch@hampshirehigh.com)
- Ø Announced tests, quizzes, and projects are due on the date announced—even though a student might have been absent. Attendance is essential.
- Ø All students will take the Final at the end of semester which will count 15% of entire grade
- Ø **Other:**
- Ø Students will use Computers/Internet, view authentic movies or materials essential for language acquisition, practice, review and Culture information
