HOSTING CONTRACT

Our Italian guests will be arriving in April/May 2025. We have to start working as a group and make necessary preparations together for when the Italians arrive, Rules and regulations and the obligations of host families are listed below. In order for you to participate as a host family, parents and students must agree to abide by these stated rules, regulations, and obligations. Your signature on this form indicates your willingness to serve as a host family and abide by these rules, regulations, and obligations.

- 1. Under no circumstances are Italian students to be in a car driven by an American student. School bus transportation will be provided free of charge to and from school; however, Italian students should not have to ride the school bus by themselves or be left on their own if the American student is involved in extra-curricular activities.
- 2. Under no circumstances is an American student to take an exchange student on any type of trip without adult supervision.
- 3. American students who have jobs--the Italian students are not to be left alone for any significant period of time. Therefore, it is recommended that if an American student has a job s/he arrange with the employer for a leave of absence for the time of the exchange program.
- 4. Student meetings and parties in the afternoon/evening in a larger group without parent **AND** teacher supervision are not permitted. The principal is in favor of a cultural exchange but she is also very strict about the rules. She wishes that students notify the teachers when meeting in groups after school. In addition, an Italian and an American teacher always need to be present for supervision.
- 5. No host family trips are to be scheduled which interfere with group trips/activities unless prior notification.
- 6. A private bedroom (and bathroom) is not a requirement for same sex students.
- 7. The Italian students are not permitted to smoke at school. Smoking in your home is something that you need to address with your student. State law forbids drinking of alcoholic beverages! All students and host families must abide by the law!
- 8. Limit time with your boy/girl friend while you are hosting. Many Italians have been left at home alone in front of TV while American partner was out on a date!
- 9. When at HHS, lunch will be provided for the Italian students.
- 10. Remember, the point of this trip is for Italians to experience American culture—please help them improve their English, encourage them to experience American foods, and participate in the typical daily activities of American families living in Hampshire County, WV.

We want to assure you that being a host family is a deeply rewarding and satisfying experience. The possibility of a deep, lifelong friendship with a student from Italy is a very real possibility. We also want to thank you in advance for your generosity in opening up your home to an Italian student and promise that we will do all in our power to make the hosting experience positive, educational, and enjoyable.
