The Italian Exchange is a cultural exchange program, open to all HHS students who qualify and are selected to participate. Based on the above criteria for eligibility, students will be selected after the deadline of January 23, 2024. Parent/s and students need to attend the mandatory January 25, 2024 meeting. We will travel to our exchange school in November; Italian students are likely to come again after Easter in 2025. Hampshire High students will stay/host the same students when in Italy and Italians come here to the US.

Included in the program is a 9/10-day trip to Sicily along with Florence, Rome and the Vatican and more.. While on this trip, we will charter a bus to get around. We will be staying in Hotels. During this 9/10-day trip, we will be visiting interesting sights and places such as Greek temples and amphitheaters,



various sights in Rome and Florence, to mention only a few. For preparation, we will meet two times a month after school (starting January 25, 2024) for classes to prepare students for the trip, discuss readings, general preparation, and Italian/Greek culture. While staying in Italy, students will be participating in a home-stay program with full immersion into Italian culture. Students will be participating in everyday life activities such as going to school and projects with Italian students. Also planned are excursions to Milan
